Frank Bevilacqua has been with the ODA since 1991, in various roles, and currently serves as CEO.

Frank provides leadership to a successful and financially sound voluntary dental association, the largest in Canada, with revenues of ~\$20 million, net assets of ~\$25 million and assets of ~\$40 million. With its for profit subsidiary, Accerta, the ODA has ~\$60 million in assets on a consolidated basis. As CEO, his responsibilities include providing: strategic, financial, administrative, human resources, public and compliance leadership. In conjunction with the Board, the CEO is responsible for the development and execution of the ODA's Strategic Plan, the maintenance of effective governance processes and structures, and accountability to the ODA's General Council. The CEO is also responsible for maintaining productive relationships with various dental and non-dental stakeholders, and for ensuring the ODA fulfils a leadership role at the national level.

As an experienced association leader, Frank is involved in the management of a professional association with over 91 percent membership. He is a results oriented CEO with proven leadership, strategic, management, negotiation and organizational skills. He is experienced with financial management of a large association, and with revenue generation, change management, volunteer development, motivation and coaching. He has played a key role in the volunteer/staff partnership needed to lead a successful organization. He is experienced in working with various governance models and leadership styles, as well as with a range of staff/volunteer driven models.

Formerly a Senior Consultant with a leading Canadian government relations consulting firm, Frank has worked with various corporations and associations in areas like health care, the pharmaceutical industry, resources, aeronautics, construction and high-tech sectors.
